FRANK A. AGATHEN, SR.

The funeral of Frank A. Agathen whose death was noted in our last issue was held Wednesday morning, March 13th, from St. Theresa church of which the family are members, Father Elsinger, pastor, officiating. Interment was in the new church cemetery in the family lot where he buried his son and his wife.

Mr. Agathen was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Agathen and was born in Westphalia, Germany, Aug. 16, 1848. When he was six years of age the family came to Eagle and located on a farm north of Eagle which farm is still owned by members of the family.

In 1885 he was married to Miss Elizabeth Kloppenburg, daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Frank Kloppenburg, Sr. One son was born to this union, Leo, who died in May 1915. Mrs. Agathen died in December, 1927. After the death of his wife he made his home with his nephew, Frank J. Agathen up to the time of his death, March 10th. Mr. Agathen was the last member of the Agathen family to pass on, his brothers, Anton, August and John and his sister, Mrs. Theresa Drebs, preceded him in death. Mr. Agathen was active in politics in his younger years and was often elected to town office. He was honorable in all his dealings and besides his neices and nephews he leaves many friends to mourn his death.
