Harry J. Arndt died at his farm home Saturday, Sept. 4th after an illness of many months duration. Mr. Arndt was born Sept. 29, 1897 at Milwaukee and when 18 years of age he came to Eagle and started farming on the Asa Perry farm in partnership with Aug. Schwartz for three years. In Nov. 29th, 1919 he was married to Caroline Rostowski and the young couple started farming on the Ed. Mackold farm where they remained for four years. On March 12, 1928 they purchased the Piper farm and where they are held in the highest esteem by all neighbors and friends. Mr. Arndt was a kind and loving father, upright in all his dealings. Always willing to lend a helping hand to those in need. The funeral took place Wednesday from St. John's Evangelical Lutheran church at North Prairie at 2:30 p. m. where he laid in state from 10 a. m. Rev. Winter officiating. Burial was in North Prairie cemetery.

Mr. Arndt leaves to mourn his loss besides his widow, four children, Pvt. Harry Arndt, Jr., who is in the South West Pacific, Ralph, Margaret and Evelyne at home. Also three brothers, William, Emil and Ervin, and two sisters, Elsie, Mrs. Aug. Schwartz; and Frieda, Mrs. John Windhauser all of Milwaukee. Those who acted as pallbearers were all close associates of the deceased, namely: Fred Bowery, John Schmidt, George Wilton, Otto Marquardt, Andrew Sherman and Walter Mueller, the last two mentioned acted with Mr. Arndt as members of the School Board Dist.
