Robert M. Berglin, 21, of Wisconsin Dells, formerly of Palmyra, died early Monday morning, April 7, from injuries suffered in a one car accident outside Portage.

He was born on April 25, 1975, to Lyle and Kris (Olson) Berglin in Palmyra. He lived and grew up in Palmyra, graduating from Palmyra High School in 1993. He was very active in school: lettering in baseball and football and was also very active in track. He was a member of the National Honor Society and received scholarships in computer science and bowling. Bob was also very active with the Palmyra High School Band, the Jazz Band, and the Drama Club.

He attended UW-Whitewater for three years, where he was also active with school activities. He was currently working as a dealer for Ho-Chunk Casinos and was planning to re-enter UW-Whitewater this coming fall.

Robert is survived by his parents, Lyle and Kris; a sister, Kimberly; grandfathers, Kenneth Berglin of Palmyra and Gerald Olson of Whitewater; aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by one sister, Michelle, and by his grandmothers, Ida Berglin and Jean Olson.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, April 9, at the Palmyra United Methodist Church, Palmyra, with burial in Hillside Cemetery, Palmyra. Rev. Ann Luzader officiated.
