On January 26th, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Roxy Betts Blank at Waukesha, occurred the death of Mrs. Jennie Coulter Betts after a long illness. Mrs. Betts was a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. James Coulter of Troy Center, and was born in Utica, New York, June 22d, 1855. Came to Troy Center with her parents and grew to womanhood there. Was married to Charles M. Betts, of Eagle, Dec. 31, 1879, at East Troy, son of Jonathan Betts, pioneer settler here. Three children were born to this union, John J. of West Allis; Roxy Blank, Waukesha, and Clara Kuehn, Eagle. Mr. Betts died in 1919.
