EAGLE — James F. Bovee, age 96, of Highway 99, Eagle, died Thursday, Jan. 9, 1992 at the Kiwanis Manor Nursing Home in East Troy. He was born Dec. 3, 1895, on the family farm in Eagle to Marvin and Margaret Bovee.

He was a fourth generation farmer on the family farm in the town of Eagle. He had served on the Eagle Town Board for 40 years as a supervisor and later as Town Board chairman. He had also been on the Waukesha County Board. He had been a member of the Masonic Lodge for 71 years, presently a member of the Rob Morris Lodge No. 68 in Palmyra.

He is survived by son, J. Marty Bovee of Eagle; daughter, Dorothy (William) Clark of Milwaukee; two granddaughters; two grandsons; two great-grandsons; sister, Katherine Howard of Waukesha; nieces; nephews; cousins, other relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by his wife, Fern, who died in 1990.

Funeral services will be held at 2:30 p.m. Saturday, Jan. 11, at the Mealy's Funeral Home in Eagle. The Rev. Sandra Gaylord will officiate with burial in Oakridge Cemetery in Eagle.
