OBIT. - HAHN, WILLIAM

STATE OF WISCONSIN.—WAUKESHA COUNTY.—In County Court.

In the matter of the Estate of William Hahn, deceased.

On reading and filing an instrument in writing purporting to be the last will and testament of William Hahn, late of the town of Ottawa, Waukesha County, deceased, and also the accompanying petition of Arthur Stead, representing among other things, that the said William Hahn lately died an inhabitant of the said County of Waukesha, in Wisconsin, testate, and that Arthur Stead is named and appointed in said instrument as executor thereof and praying that the said instrument may be proved and letters testamentary granted thereon according to law.

It is ordered, That the said petition be heard before the said Court at a special term thereof to be held at the Court House in said county, on the third Tuesday of November, A. D. 1912, being the 19th day of said month, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon of said day, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard.

It is further ordered, that notice of said hearing be given to all persons interested in said estate by publishing a copy of this order for three weeks successively, previous to said hearing, in the Eagle Quill, a weekly newspaper printed and published in said County.
