Jerome Mealy, 72 Died Monday

The community of Eagle was shocked Monday morning to receive news of the sudden passing of Jerome Mealy at Ironton, Wisconsin, that morning.

He and Mrs. Mealy were visiting at the home of her sister in Ironton and the end came suddenly following a heart attack.

Mr. Mealy was 72 and came to Eagle 40 years ago to establish a funeral and furniture business. In those 40 years Mr. Mealy contributed no small part to the civic activities of the village. His loyalty and friendliness endeared him to his fellow citizens and residents of the Eagle rural area.

In addition to his business activities here he had for many years served the needs of the community of Dousman.

He is survived by his wife, Cecelia, and two sons, Joseph and Kenneth, of Eagle. Kenneth has been associated with his father in the Mealy firm. Two grandchildren and an older brother, Henry, also survive. He was a member of St. Theresa's Church.

Services will be held Friday at 9:30 a. m. at St. Theresa's with Rev. George Budde officiating and burial in the church cemetery.
