EAGLE - Milton M. Mueller, age 59, of Eagle St., Eagle, died Thursday, May 17, 1990 at Waukesha Memorial Hospital.

He was born July 6, 1930, at Eagle, to Martin and Ella (Brühle) Mueller.

He is a lifelong resident of Eagle. He had worked for the Department of Natural Resources in Eagle for 9 years. He was presently employed for the Village of Eagle as Park and Street Superintendent and the Village Licensed Water Operator. He has worked for the Village since 1962. He is a member of St. John's Lutheran Church, a member of the Sargent Splechter-Schmidt Post 535 American Legion of Eagle. He is Fire Chief of the Eagle Volunteer Fire Department and has been a member since Dec. of 1963, 27½ years. He was a member of the Waukesha County Association of Fire Chiefs, veteran of the Korean War where he was a sergeant in the Marine Corps. He was president of the Jericho Cemetery Association, and a member of the Eagle Historical Society.

He is survived by his wife, Marjorie (Huebner). They were married in Elkhorn on June 19, 1954.

Further survived by daughter, Michelle of Watertown; mother, Ella Mueller of Eagle; brother, Dale Mueller of Palmyra, nieces, nephews, other relatives and many friends.

He was preceded in death by his father, Martin.

Funeral services will be at 4 p.m., Sunday, May 20, 1990 at St. John's Lutheran Church, 312 N. Main St., North Prairie. Pastor Daniel Gartzke will officiate with burial in Jericho Cemetery, Eagle.
