### Fr. Norbert C. Neuens

Services for Father Norbert C. Neuens, 31, a Menomonee Falls priest who died recently of injuries suffered in an automobile accident were held in St. Mary's Catholic church, Menomonee Falls.

The office of the dead was recited at 10:30 a. m., followed by a pontifical high mass at 11 a. m. Burial was in the church cemetery.

Father Neuens, who frequently spoke out on civil rights issues, was a member of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People. He was assistant pastor at St. Mary's.

He was director of the Young Catholic Workers in the parish, the director of the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine in the parish and chaplain of the Christian Family Movement at St. Mary's.

Born in Athens, Wis., Father Neuens attended Messmer high school in Milwaukee and Sacred Heart high school in Watertown.

He entered St. Francis seminary in 1951 and was ordained May 28, 1960.

He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Neuens, Menomonee Falls; three sisters, Mrs. Raymond Bong and Mrs. Glenn Goehring, both of Menomonee Falls, and Sister Carl Marie, O.S.F., Jackson, Miss., and three brothers, Robert, Michael and John, all at home.

Father Neuens attended St. Theresa parochial school when they lived at Eagle and has relatives and friends here. He was a nephew of Mrs. Anton Steinhoff.
