Death of Mrs. Susan Parks.

Last Friday news of the death of Mrs. Susan Parks, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. P. L. Heinrichs, of Davenport, Iowa, came as a surprise to her friends at Eagle. She had but recently gone there on a visit and was to stay only a few days. The remains were brought to Eagle and interred in Oak Ridge cemetery Sunday afternoon beside the remains of her husband, who died a few years ago. Her maiden name was Susan Wedd, and she was born in England, April 15, 1826, and came to America six years later to Brandon, Vt. In 1854 the family came to Eagle, where she was married on November 28, 1855, and with the exception of a time in Mukwonago and East Troy, always resided here. She leaves surviving her a son, W. Parks, of Pocahontas, Okla., and two daughters, Mrs. P. L. Edwards of Eagle. During her residence here Mrs. Parks always maintained friendly relations with all the people. She was of a domestic taste and devoted her time largely to her home and family. We extend our sympathy.
