Funeral of Mrs. Peacock,

The remains of Mrs. Annie Peacock will be brought to Milwaukee tomorrow afternoon, arriving here over the North-Western railroad at 1:45 o'clock. The funeral will take place at 2 o'clock from the station, interment being at Calvary. Mrs. Peacock, who had made her home in Milwaukee for the past forty years, was on a visit to her son, William Peacock, at Jefferson Park, Ill., when stricken with fatal illness. She was born in England in 1823 and came to this country something over forty years ago, locating in Milwaukee two years after her arrival in the United States. She was the wife of Frank A. Peacock, who died in this city about 1860. She leaves five children, three sons and two daughters, the sons being Samuel F. of this city, and Frank X. and William Peacock of Chicago, and the daughters, Mrs. Wolf of Chicago and Mrs. George Phinney of Eagle, Wis.
