

Alfred E. Baker, Eagle

Palmyra — Alfred Ernest Baker, 81, a life-long resident of Eagle, died Friday night after an illness of only two days. Death was attributed to ptomaine poisoning.

Mr. Baker was born March 25, 1857, in the town of Troy and had been a farmer all his life. He was the last of his immediate family. Several nieces and nephews survive.
