Rites For Mrs. Baker Held On Sunday

Mrs. Richard Baker died early last Thursday morning at her home, 600 Janesville street, following a brief illness.

Ella May Coombe, daughter of Thomas and Thamsin Hutchins Coombe was born at Zion, Jefferson county, Wisconsin on February 20, 1864.

At the age of three years she moved with her parents to Adams, Walworth county. On December 31, 1885 she married Richard Baker and they made their home on a farm south of Eagle. In 1917 they moved to Whitewater where she has since lived. Mr. Baker died September 14, 1935.

Mrs. Baker was a member of the Little Prairie Methodist church and a member of the Ladies' Aid Circle of the W.S.C.S. of the Whitewater Methodist church.

Surviving are two sons, Ralph and Levi Baker, both of Eagle; two daughters, Emma and Eunice Baker of Whitewater; six grandchildren and two great grandchildren, also a brother, Levi Coombe, who resides at the Baker home. A daughter, Ruby, Mrs. Floyd Box, died in 1918.

Funeral services were held at the Skindingsrude and Lein funeral home last Sunday afternoon, the Rev. Alfred Hoad officiating. Burial was at the Little Prairie cemetery.
