Services will be held Tuesday for Beulah I. Bayer of Waukesha, a retired teacher. She died Saturday at the Virginia Health Care Center in Waukesha, where she had been a resident for the past four years. She was 95.

She attended Whitewater Normal School and graduated from the Milwaukee Normal School.

Her teaching career began in 1912 at Ottawa School District No. 9. She also taught at other Waukesha County schools, ending her career at the Eagle Graded School, where she taught the upper grades at the time of her retirement in 1935.

She was a longtime member of the First United Methodist Church of Waukesha. Until recently, she was active in the United Methodist Women.

Visitation will be held from 12:30 p.m. until services at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the Randle-Dable Funeral Home Inc., 1110 S. Grand Ave., Waukesha. The Rev. Frank Gaylord will officiate. Burial will follow at Oak Ridge Cemetery in Eagle.
