Mrs. Abraham Beachtel Dead.

Mrs. Abraham Beachtel died at Troy Center last Saturday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. E. B. Babcock. Mrs. Beachtel was born in Middlesex, N. Y., September 25, 1829, and came to Wisconsin with her parents at the age of sixteen. Her maiden name was Sarah Henry. She was married to Abraham Beachtel at the age of eighteen and resided in the town of Eagle on the farm now owned by J. F. Braun until their removal to Troy Center, where they conducted a hotel for many years. About fourteen years ago they retired from business life and resided with their son, Frank. Mr. Beachtel preceded her in death about twelve years ago. Four children were born to them, all of whom are living: Mrs. George Sovey, Mrs. Charles Cox, Mrs. E. W. Babcock and Frank Beachtel. The funeral took place at Troy Center Monday afternoon, Rev. Mr. Lugg of Whitewater officiating.
