EAGLE - Jerrold M. "Jerry" Berger of Eagle died on Saturday, June 19, 1999, at Waukesha Memorial Hospital at the age of 68. He was born on May 11, 1931, in Milwaukee, the son of Matthew and Esther (nee Lueck) Berger. Jerry owned his own excavating company, J.M. Berger Excavating & Grading Co. in Brookfield, for many years. He worked on the Milwaukee County Free-way Project in the mid-1960s and also worked in the development of the New Berlin Industrial Park in the early 1970s. Jerry retired in 1995. Jerry was a former member of the Master Landscape Gardeners Association of Wisconsin. In addition to his work, Jerry loved music and was an avid accordionist.
