Was married to Charles M. Betts, of Eagle, Dec. 31, 1879, at East Troy, son of Jonathan Betts, pioneer settler here. Three children were born to this union, John J. of West Allis; Roxy Blank, Waukesha, and Clara Kuehn, Eagle. Mr. Betts died in 1919.
