### Mrs. Dan Clohisy Dead

Word was received here by relatives Monday of the passing of Millie McCabe Clohisy, daughter of the late Andrew and Amorette McCabe, who were early pioneers of this vicinity, where Mrs. Clohisy was born December 12, 1866. Here she spent her entire girlhood and on Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 28, 1889 was married to Dan Clohisy. To this union two children were born, Horton, who died in infancy and Warren now of Wilmette, Ill. They made their home at Eagle and for several years prior to moving to Chicago, Mr. Clohisy served as mail carrier. About 25 years ago they left Eagle to make their home with their son, Warren at Chicago. Mr. Clohisy preceded her in death 12 years ago.

Mrs. Clohisy was of a home loving disposition, always devoted to her family and friends and a staunch Catholic. She leaves to mourn her loss her son and daughter-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Warren Clohisy and a grandson, Warren, Jr., and a grand daughter Ruth, now Mrs. Frederick Floburg and several nieces and nephews.
