'Central' Dies at Dousman

Dousman's "Central" for nearly a generation, Miss Ruby Earle, 57, died yesterday at the home of her sister, Mrs. Charles Cole. She had been ill for more than a year.

Miss Earle had been with the Northwest Telephone Co. for almost 25 years, and was, chief operator at the Dousman exchange for 20 years. She was born in the town of Eagle but lived most of her life in Dousman.
