

DIED—In the village of Eagle, Wis., Sept. 11, 1890. at 2:30 p. m., Edgar L. Henry, aged 31 years, 3 months and 12 days. The deceased was born in this town, was a painter by trade, and being unmarried, has for some years made his parents house his home, and where after an illness of about six months he died. Last winter Edgar had an attack of la grippe, having at the time a slight cough, and the disease seemed to settle on his lungs, running him into consumption, which disease was the immediate cause of his death. He was a young man of a cheerful disposition, kind and affectionate to his parents. Conscious of his approaching end, he met death bravely and without a murmur. He has left a father, mother, one brother and one sister to mourn his death. His funeral took place at the M. E. Church last Sunday and was largely attended by his friends and acquaintances.
