




Hon. JOHN HODGSON.

THE DEATH OF MR. HODGSON.

It becomes our painful duty to inform our readers that our friend and fellow-citizen, John Hodgson, Esq., died at his residence at half past two o'clock yesterday morning. The attack of heart disease, which he received at four o'clock Monday morning, the 13th instant, was a very violent one, and although the best medical skill of Waukesha and Milwaukee was secured, his recovery, from the very nature of the case, seemed almost impossible. His disease at times caused him the most excruciating pain, but he bore his sufferings without a murmur. His sudden death willadden the hearts and surprise his large circle of warm friends especially those who have been intimately acquainted with him for the last quarter of a century. No man in the county will be more regretted than Mr. Hodgson. He possessed so many virtues, was so pure minded, liberal, and warm hearted, that it was impossible not to love and honor him.

The funeral services will take place at the Derwent farm, the family residence, on Saturday morning, at eleven o'clock, whence the remains will be taken to the cemetery in this village for interment.
