WAUKESHA – Lifelong Waukesha resident Andrew "Andy" C. Hunkins died Monday, May 6, 2002, at Waukesha Memorial Hospital at age 79. He was born in Waukesha on March 20, 1923, the son of Grover and Agnes (nee Ross) Hunkins.
