EAGLE — Louise B. Hyland, age 94, of Thomas Street, Eagle, died Saturday, Jan. 17, 1998, at the Masonic Health Care Center in Dousman. She was born March 13, 1903, in Eagle, to Bernard and Anna (Liebel) Breidenbach. Louise lived in Eagle and the surrounding community all her life. She was a longtime member of St. Theresa's Catholic Church in Eagle. She is remembered as a member of the Eagle Community Band and also while a telephone operator for the community, she was able to stop an attempted robbery in process at the Eagle State Bank in 1919.

Survivors include her sons, Kenneth (Ellie) Hyland of Wales and James (Cay) Hyland of Nashville, Tenn.; daughters, Patricia (Mike) Michael of Miami, Fla. and Kathleen (Dale) Mohr of Wisconsin Dells. She was preceded in death by her husband, John; daughter, Maureen and two sons, Robert and Jerry.
