Stephen N. Johnston Sr., 94, died Friday, March 26, 2004, at his daughter's home in Oconomowoc.



He was born Dec. 7, 1908, in Milwaukee, the son of Harry and Jessie (nee Norbeck) Johnston. Stephen was the great-grandson of the founder of the Robert A. Johnston Co., now known as
