Mrs. Herman Kahlke

On Saturday word reached the village of the passing of Mrs. Herman Kahlke on Friday evening at her home west of the village. Ill but a few days her death came with all the force of a surprise to all in the neighborhood.

Of a quiet and unassuming disposition, Mrs. Kahlke rarely ever left her home except to attend services at St. Theresa's church, of which she was a devout member. She was born at Shawano, Wis, August 25, 1882, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Tom Kubly. On September 9, 1908 she was married to Herman Kahlke and to this union one son was born. She also reared and cared for a niece and two nephews, who were left orphaned by the death of their mother, Mrs. Kahlke's sister. To them she gave a mother's care and attention. Funeral services took place from the Mealy Funeral chapel to St. Theresa's Catholic church Tuesday morning at 9 a. m. Rev. George Wollet officiating. Burial was in St. Theresa's Oak Knoll cemetery.
