Marvin J. Kennedy

May 9, 1927 – Aug. 10, 2003

Marvin J. Kennedy, of Mukwonago, passed away after a lengthy illness on Sunday, Aug. 10, 2003, at Linden Grove



in New Berlin at age 76. Marvin was born in the town of North Prairie in Columbia County on May 9,

1927, the son of Joseph and Clara (nee Schmidt) Kennedy.

Marvin served his country during World War II in the United States Navy.
