Laura Sprague Kilts

Laura Sprague Kilts was born at Osage, Iowa in 1858 to Lucy Ann Cummings and Frederick Sprague. She moved with her parents and one brother and three sisters to Eagle Prairie, when she was about six years old. She was united in marriage on March 9th, 1881 to Franklin E. Kilts and to them on April 28th, 1886, one son was born, Sidney Franklin. He died on April 24th, 1928. Her husband died on Sept. 25th, 1933. Since his death she has lived with her daughter-in-law and her husband, now Mrs. Julius Amann.
