WAUKESHA - Longtime Waukesha resident Joe A. Kutschenreuter died Wednesday, April 17, 2002, at Waukesha Memorial Hospital at age 84. He was born March 14, 1918, in Eagle, the son of Herman and Rose (nee Kohler) Kutschenreuter.
