MAGDALENA R. LOIBL

On Saturday night, December 27, about nine o'clock Miss Magdalena R. Loibl was stricken with apoplexy and died Monday morning at two o'clock twenty minutes. Miss Loibl was born in the town of Eagle Oct. 28th, 1864 and was a daughter of the late Wolfgang and Katharina Waas Loibl. She spent her early life on the homestead west of the village and moved to the village eleven years ago and kept house with her brother Henry M. Loibl publisher of this paper. Her death came with all the force of surprise.

The funeral took place from St. Theresa church of which she was a member, Wednesday forenoon. Rev. Elsinger pastor, officiating. Interment was in the family lot in the new church cemetery where her parents lie buried. She leaves surviving her one brother above named and two sisters, Mrs. Anna M. Scheideler and Mrs. Theresa Kyle of Wymore, Nebraska; and many other relatives. Two sisters Mrs. Katharina Vonrueden of Westby, Wis., and Mrs. Mary I.
