
Obituary.

Died, at his home in Eagle Village, on Friday, May 5, Mr. Jacob Way, one of the old settlers of this township. Mr. Way was born in Amsterdam, Montgomery County, New York, in October, 1809, and was in his 84th year at his death. He was married in New York state and after residing at Utica and other places in New York state he came to Eagle in 1845 and settled on a farm in the southwest portion of the town. Although well along in years his almost daily occupation was farming. With a strong will and great determination he worked almost to the last minute of his life. His death was caused by accident while engaged in unloading a farm tool from his wagon in his field some distance from his late home. His horses took fright and ran away and threw him against a stone pile, resulting in the fracture of his skull. The accident occurred on Wednesday noon and death followed on the following Friday. Mr. Way leaves a widow and three children all grown up and settled comfortably. The funeral was held at the M. E. Church, Rev. Medland officiating. Interment was made at the old cemetery south of the village on Sunday last. A large concourse of citizens were in attendance.
