### Christian John Lins

Christian John Lins, 91, died Friday . afternoon, Jan. 3 at Waukesha Memorial hospital. He was born Jan. 13, 1872, the son of Edmund Sr. and Henrietta Macholdt Lins.

He attended Eagle State Graded School, Spencerian Business College and Marquette University.

He was employed as treasurer of the Wisconsin Telephone company for several years and later by Romadka Bros. in the leather goods business. Later on he formed a partnership with James P. McKane and they established a leather goods store and factory in Milwaukee under the name of McKane-Lins which is still operating under that name.

About 14 years ago he suffered a stroke which left him an invalid. Since that time he has lived with his sisters in Eagle. On Dec. 22 he suffered another stroke and was taken to Waukesha where after lingering for two weeks he died.

He was a member of the Holy Name Society, Happy Death Society of Gesu Church, Milwaukee, and a life member of Knights of Columbus.

He leaves to mourn his death two sisters, Louise and Mrs. Isabel Engebretsen. His parents, two sisters and a brother preceded him in death.

Funeral services were held Tuesday from St. Theresa church, Rev. Robert Schubert officiating. Burial was in the family lot in Oak Knoll cemetery.
