## Long-time Eagle Grocer, Mrs. Sherman, Dies

EAGLE — Eulalia A. Sherman, 85, grocery store operator in Eagle with her husband Vinton from 1921 to 1968, died Tuesday at Waukesha Memorial Hospital of complications of age.

She had lived with her husband, who survives her, at 119 Main St., Eagle.

When they closed their store, it marked the end of 60 years of storekeeping for her husband. His grandmother had operated a confectionery in Eagle. It was taken over by his mother, who had a new store built in 1905. She converted it from a confectionery to a grocery store.

Vinton Sherman had helped out in both his grandmother's and mother's shops and, when he and Eulalia — nicknamed "La" — Clohisy married in 1921, they operated the grocery store together.

No other shop in Eagle has ever been under one ownership for so long a time as the Sherman Grocery.

Mrs. Sherman was a member of St. Theresa Catholic Church, its choir and Women's Altar Society and was treasurer of the St. Theresa Mission Society.

Her only immediate survivor is her husband.

The funeral will be at 11 a.m. Thursday at St. Theresa Church. Friends may call after 4 p.m. today at Mealy's Funeral Home in Eagle, where a vigil service will be at 8 tonight. Burial will be in the church cemetery.
