WAUKESHA — Mary E. Sherman, age 87, of Waukesha, formerly of Mukwonago and North Prairie, died Sunday, March 22, 1992, at Waukesha Memorial Hospital. She was born Feb. 15, 1905, at East Troy to William and Sarah Plout.

After she was graduated from high school, she was a school teacher in the Genesee area until 1940. She married Clarence Sherman who preceded her in death. They owned and operated Sherman's Grocery Store, North Prairie, in the 1940s, 50s and 60s. After the death of her husband she moved to Mukwonago. In the early 1970s she worked at Sentry in Mukwonago in the Bakery Department. Five years ago she moved to Waukesha.

Survivors are her daughter, Ceil M. (Thomas) Herman of Waukesha and grandchildren, Natalie (Jonathan) Larson and John (Amy) Nielsen, both of Minneapolis. She also is survived by other relatives and friends.
