Mrs. Sylvia Sherman

In the early morning hours of September 16, 1958, occurred the death of Mrs. Sylvia Sherman, 91, a long time resident and business woman of Eagle Village. She had been in failing health for the past five years after suffering from a broken hip.

Her early years in the village were spent operating a confectionary and grocery store after which she found her happiness in managing a gift shop.

Mrs. Sherman was a member of the Eagle Methodist Church and a member of the Royal Neighbors of America.

Her son Vinton and wife survive her, as does a brother, Jay W. Stead of Eagle, also four nieces and four nephews.

Mrs. Sherman was born in Mukwonago Town November 26, 1867. In 1888 she was married to James A. Sherman, who eight years later preceded her in death. To this union was born one son, Vinton J. Sherman, who now operates the V. J. Sherman Grocery Store.

Eagle has indeed lost a most revered and beloved citizen. Her many acts of kindness through the years will be a living memorial to her memory.

Funeral services were held Thursday afternoon at the Methodist Church at 2 p. m. with burial in Oak Ridge Cemetery, Eagle.
