Dr. Robert L. Simon

NORTH PRAIRIE — Dr. Robert L. Simon, age 95, of Main Street, North Prairie, died Wednesday, March 4, 1998, at Kiwanis Manor in East Troy. He was born May 14, 1902, in Barberton, Ohio, to Harry and Lottie Simon. Dr. Simon married his wife, Millie, at St. John's Lutheran Church in North Prairie on Dec. 22, 1956.

Dr. Simon grew up in Orrville, Ohio, and graduated from Orrville High School in 1920. He began Osteopathic studies at the Chicago College of Osteopathy in 1928, transferred to Philadelphia College of Osteopathy in 1931, and graduated in 1933. He practiced in Milwaukee, Watertown, Hustisford and New London before going into the service in World War II. He entered Hospital Corp. U.S. Navy for four years in 1941. He served two years in Malarial Control Unit, South Pacific. He returned to practice in Sullivan in 1945, and moved to North Prairie in 1947. He retired from practice in 1975.

He was a member of St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church in North Prairie, American Osteopathic Association, Philadelphia College Alumni Association, and was a charter member North Prairie Lions Club.

He is survived by his darling wife, Millie; sister, Ruth Wells of Orrville, Ohio; brother, Victor Simon of Sun City, Ariz.; loving nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by his parents and three sisters: Betty, Catherine and Evelyn.

The funeral will be at noon Saturday, March 7, 1998, at the St. John's Lutheran Church in North Prairie. The Rev. Lester Dumer (former pastor of St. John's) will officiate, with burial at North Prairie Cemetery. Friends may call from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. Friday at the Mealy's Funeral Home in Eagle and from 11 a.m. until time of services on Saturday at the church. Memorials may be made to the donor's choice.
