## THE LATE ISAAC SMART.

Mr. Smart was born in Yorkshire, Eng., on sept, 15th, 1809. His boyhood and part of his early manhood were spent there. In August 1835 he was married to Miss Elizabeth Clegg, who was also a native of Yorkshire. In 1834 he came with his wife and one child to Detroit, where they remained for a short time and passed on to White Pigeon, in the same state. Here he remained until March, 1835, when he came to Waukesha.

Mr. Smart was the father of six children, four of whom survive him. His wife, the companion of his toil and sacrifices, passed away Dec. 4, 1889. Mr. Smart was highly respected, and possessed a genial disposition. His toil won him great reward.

The closing weeks of his life were full of pain, and death released him from suffering Feb. 18. The funeral was held at his late home in the presence of a large number of sorrowing friends, the remains were interred at
