DEATHS.

Mrs. Robert Smart, one of the pioneer settlers of this township, died at her home three and one-half miles north-west of the village at 12:30 o'clock Monday afternoon in the 67th year of her age.

Deceased was born in Broad Albin, Fulton County, N. Y., in 1836, her maiden name being Jane Culbert, and while a young girl accompanied her parents to Wisconsin and located near Brown's Corners in the town of Genesee. She and Robert Smart were married soon thereafter and moved to her present estate which they purchased from the government.

Her husband died in 1893, a daughter, Mrs. Mabel Asche, died in October 1900. She is survived by Fred Smart, Saylesville, Archie, who resides on the old homestead, Mesdames H. E. Miller, Mukwonago; Belle Chasin, Chicago; Celia Atkin, Waukesha; also Isabel Asche, a grand daughter, who has resided with her since her mother's death.

Mrs. Smart's continuous residence on the same farm exceeded fifty years and the testimony of her neighbors confirm that she was a remarkably intelligent, benevolent, enthusiastic neighbor and a model wife, mother and citizen.

The funeral was held from the home Thursday at 10:30 o'clock, Rev. C. W. Merritt officiating. Interment in the village cemetery.—Chief.
