

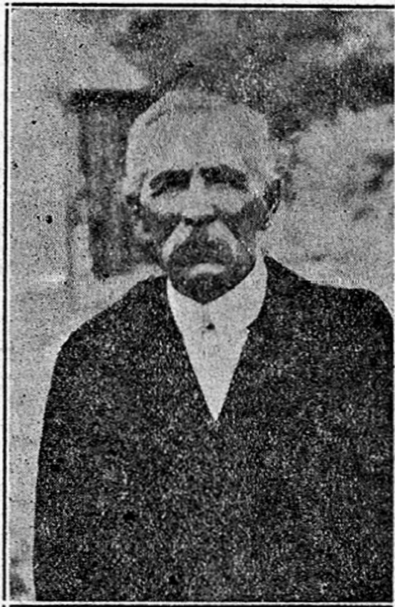

Obituary

Thomas Smart was born at Mukwanego, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, Dec. 20, 1843, and died at his home in this city Jan. 23, 1927.

When but 14 months old his mother died, and he afterwards lived with relatives until July 3, 1865, when Miss Libbie A. Purvis was married to him at Mukwanego.

In 1868 they moved to a farm in the town of Fountain, this county, where they lived until 1914 when the farm was sold and they moved to the home in this city where he died.



Mr. Smart is survived by his wife, a son Manville Smart of Fountain, and a daughter, Mrs. Mina Jensen of town of Orange. He also leaves seven grandchildren and five greatgrandchildren; a brother, Richard of Kendall; two sisters, Mrs. Addie Slickels of Sioux City, Iowa, and Mrs. Rena Lumsden of Kendall; besides numerous nephews and nieces.

He was a kind and devoted husband and father. As a neighbor and friend he was highly esteemed. As a citizen he was public-spirited and always willing to lend his assistance to any cause for the betterment of his community.

Tom Smart will be missed from this community.

Funeral services were held from the Methodist church at 1:30 p. m. yesterday. The sermon was delivered by Rev. C. W. Emery. There was a large attendance and many beautiful floral tributes. Burial was in the Hustler cemetery.
