Mrs. Frank Stevens

Mrs. Frank Stevens, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. M. Crawley, died at the home of her parents in the town of Baldwin, Saturday evening, June 14. The cause of death was uremia.

Miss Belle Crawley was born in Eagle, Waukesha county, this state, on Aug. 2, 1875, and came to this county with her parents in 1879. She was married to Frank Stevens March 8, 1903. The first two years of their married life was spent in Milwaukee, afterwards they moved to the farm in Baldwin town, where they had since resided.

Her sudden death was a great shock to everyone as all thought her to be in the best of health. Saturday morning she walked to the home of her parents, a short distance away, where she was taken sick, and it was only a few hours before her death that the gravity of her condition was made apparent.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at 1 o'clock at her parents' home and at 2 o'clock at the Presbyterian church here, Rev. Mr. Black officiating. Interment was in the Baldwin cemetery.

Many beautiful floral offerings and church decorations were evidence of the deep esteem of relatives and friends. She leaves to mourn her death, her husband, her parents, a sister, Mrs. J. B. Jacobson of Woodville, and a large number of relatives and a host of friends.—Exchange.
