Delbert Stubbs

Delbert Burnell Stubbs passed away at his home in the Village early Monday morning, August 27, 1945. Although he had been ill for the past several weeks and unable to attend his duties on the mail route, few realized the end was so near and the news of his passing came as a shock to his many friends.

Mr. Stubbs who was 51 years of age, was born at Mukwonago, Wis., the son of Orlando and Emma Stubbs. It was there he grew to manhood and received his early education. On Oct. 9, 1917 he was married to Grace Shultis of North Prairie, where they lived for several years prior to coming to Eagle.

Twenty-three years ago they moved to Eagle where Mr. Stubbs served as rural mail carrier faithfully until a few weeks before his death. He was a member of Rob Morris lodge No. 115 and of the Walter Thomas Post No. 304 of the American Legion of Palmyra. He leaves to mourn his loss his wife Grace, two sons, S/Sgt. Laurel Stubbs and Milo Stubbs S 2/c, both oversea, one daughter, Joyce, a nurse at Waukesha and one brother Everett of Madison.

Funeral services were held from the Mealy Funeral Home Thursday afternoon at 2:30. Rev. Amphlett officiating. Burial was in North Prairie Cemetery. The pall bearers were Jay W. Stead, Roy Wambold, Richard Williams, Hubert Kipp, John Heintz and Clarence Orth.
