He was a member of the Eagle Volunteer Fire Department for 30 years, and was fire chief from 1982 to 1988.

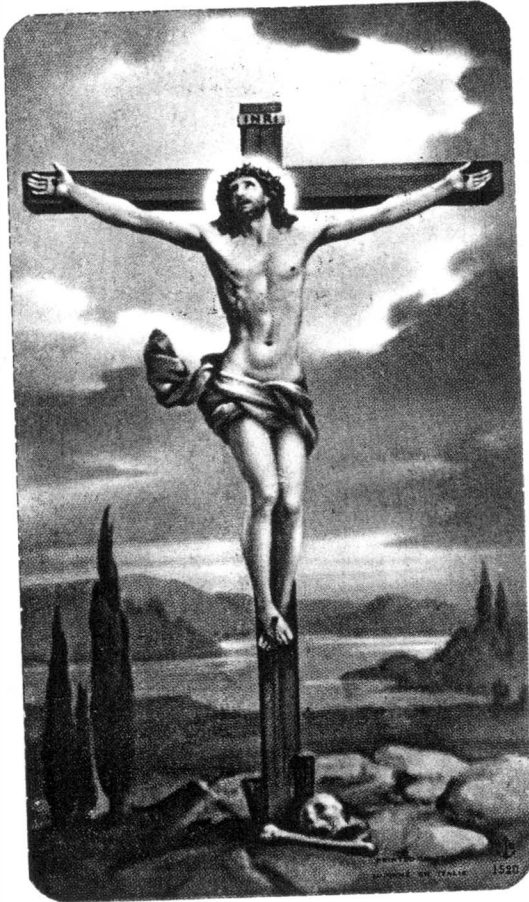
