Services will be Thursday for Ingval Ulrikson, of Waukesha, who died Monday at Waukesha Memorial Hospital. He was 95.

He was baptized and confirmed at Lands Lutheran Church in Moe, S.D. He and his wife, Lydia, farmed in the Town of Eagle from 1941 to 1991. He was a member of Grace Lutheran Church in Waukesha and the Farm Bureau. He served on the Mukwonago High School Board, beginning in 1951, and before that on the Palastine School Board.

Survivors include his wife, Lydia; two sons, Donald (June), of Mukwonago, and Gerald, of Oak Ridge, Tenn.; a sister, Clara Foussom, of Canton, S.D.; 12 grandchildren; and 13 great-grandchildren.

Visitation will be from 4 to 8 p.m. Wednesday at the Cesarz & Zinnecker Funeral Home-West, 237 N. Moreland Blvd., Waukesha, and from 10 a.m. until the services at 11 a.m. Thursday at Grace Evangelical Lutheran Church, 700 Beechwood Ave., Waukesha. The Rev. Arthur G. Koepsell will officiate. Burial is in Prairie Home Cemetery, 605 S. Prairie Ave., Waukesha.

Ingval Ulrikson of Waukesha died Nov. 13 at Waukesha Memorial Hospital at the age of 95 years.

Ulrikson was born Sept. 24, 1900 in Canton, South Dakota. He was baptized and confirmed at Lands Lutheran Church in Moe, South Dakota. He was a member of Grace Lutheran Church in Waukesha. Both he and his wife, Lydia, farmed in Eagle Township from 1941 to 1991. He was a member of the Farm Bureau, the Mukwonago High School Board beginning in 1951 and before that was a member of the Palastine School Board.

He was the beloved husband of Lydia (nee Hoeft) to whom he was married at St. John's Lutheran Church in North Prairie on June 1, 1929. He was the dear father of Donald (June) Ulrikson of Mukwonago; and Gerald Ulrikson of Oak Ridge, Tenn. He was the brother of Clara Foussom of Canton, S.D. He is also survived by 12 grandchildren, and 13 great-grandchildren. He was the father-in-law of Esther Ulrikson and Deannie Ulrikson, both of Waukesha, and other relatives and friends.

He was preceded in death by his daughter, Darlene, on July 9, 1958, and his sons: David on Dec. 30, 1990 and Dewayne on Sept. 16, 1994.

Funeral services were held Thursday at Grace Ev. Lutheran Church, Waukesha. Pastor Arthur G. Koepsell officiated. Interment was in Prairie Home Cemetery.
