NORTH PRAIRIE — Floyd E. West, age 78, of Oakridge Drive in North Prairie, died Sunday, Sept. 18, 1994, at Waukesha Memorial Hospital. He was born Oct. 14, 1915, at the family farm in the town of Mukwonago to Harvey and Pearle (nee Hinkley) West.
