On Friday morning as Mr. Carl Zarnke, who lives at Waukesha was driving to work at the Waukesha Motor Works he met instant death at the Soo Line crossing when he failed to hear the on-coming freight, which struck his car carrying the car four hundred feet or more, killing Mr. Zarnke instantly. Carl Zarnke was the husband of Marie Mueller Zarnke and formerly lived in the Mueller home on 59 for several years. About two years ago they moved to Waukesha and have since resided there. Besides his widow he is survived by two children, Audrey 14 and Marion 8; his mother, six brothers and 5 sisters.
