On Monday, February 7, 1944, the community was saddened by the news of the death of Mrs. Otto Zinn. Although she had been confined to her bed for only a few days, she had been in ill health for some time.

Mary Salisbury Zinn was born at Heart Prairie, Walworth County, December 25, 1870; however she spent her girlhood at Eagle, Wisconsin. Later she was employed in Milwaukee.

On May 31, 1902, she was married to Mr. Otto W. Zinn. Since that time they have made their home here in East Troy.

Mrs. Zinn leaves, in addition to her husband, two daughters, Katherine Mrs. A. G. Harter of Waukesha and Florence, a teacher in our local high school. She is also survived by two grandchildren, Peggy Jo and Gilbert Harter of Waukesha; two sisters, Mrs. C. A. Thompson of East Troy, and a twin sister, Mrs. H. E. Rogers of Milwaukee; and by several nieces and nephews.

Mrs. Zinn will be greatly missed, for she was a devoted mother and a loyal friend.

Having possessed high ideals, she was a constant influence for good in our community.

Funeral services were held Thursday afternoon at two o'clock at her home with Rev. Bollinger officiating. Burial will take place in Oak Ridge cemetery.
