

Veteran School Bd. Member Burton Dies

Veteran Palmyra-Eagle School Board member Donald T. Burton, 74, of Eagle died on Saturday, July 25 of an apparent heart attack at his home.

Burton had been a member of the local board of education for 21 years, 12 of those of which he served as board president.

The popular area resident was born on the family farm April 27, 1907 and had long raised turkeys and Guernsey Dairy Cattle. He was active in the American Guernsey Cattle Club and the American Dairy

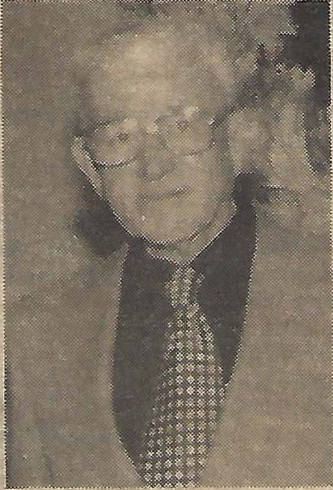
