HARRIET BOVEE M'HUGH

Mrs. Harriet Bovee McHugh died December 18th in Los Angeles after a brief illness following a fall, having had unusually good health all through the 92 years of her life. She is the last of the Matthias Bovee family who were among the early pioneers of Eagle having come from Amsterdam, New York, in 1843, Mrs. McHugh then being eight years old. She was the youngest of nine children and leaves one son and one grandson both living in California. Her remains have been cremated and will be brought here for burial beside her husband and elder son in Oak Ridge cemetery. Mrs. McHugh "Aunt Hattie" as she was affectionately called had a happy cheery disposition that saw the best side of life and it seems a fitting thing that she should spend her last years in good health and comfort.
