Anton J. Steinhoff, 92, of 523 Main, Eagle, died Tuesday morning, July 29 in Waukesha Memorial Hospital.

Born May 17, 1894, in Eagle, he married Elizabeth Lanc in 1919. She died in December 1938. He married Therese Weiler in 1942. He attended Whitewater Normal School, operated a farm in the Palmyra-Eagle area most of his life, and worked at the Waukesha Motor Co. He was a World War I Army veteran, a member of American Legion Post 535 of Eagle, St. Theresa's Catholic Church in Eagle, Knights of Columbus, and was on the board of directors at Palmyra State Bank. In the 1930s he was town chairman of Eagle and served on the Waukesha County Board.

Surviving are his wife; a son, John of Palmyra; two daughters, Carol Foelker of Fort Atkinson and Catherine Eaton of West Bend; 12 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren.

Services were at 11 a.m. Thursday, July 31 in St. Theresa's Catholic Church, Eagle, with burial in the church cemetery. Visitation was after 4 p.m. Wednesday at Mealy's Funeral Home, Eagle, where there was a Bible vigil at 7:30 p.m.
