

## John A. Steinhoff

PALMYRA — Funeral services for John A. Steinhoff, 60, of 615 Wisconsin Street, Palmyra village president, will be held Tuesday at 10:30 a.m. at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Palmyra with the Rev. Robert Buholzer officiating. Burial will be in St. Theresa's Cemetery, Eagle.

Friends and relatives may call to pay their respects at the Janssen-Molenda-Andrews Funeral Home in Palmyra today from 4 to 9 p.m., where a parish vigil will be held at 7:30 p.m.

Steinhoff was born March 16, 1927 in Eagle, son of Anton and Elizabeth Steinhoff. He married the former Jean L. Emery Sept. 16, 1950 in Eagle.

Steinhoff was a Palmyra-Eagle resident all of his life, living on a farm between Palmyra and Eagle until moving to the village of Palmyra in 1957. He had been employed as a union carpenter with United Brotherhood of Carpenters Local 1573 in Milwaukee. He was a member of Knights of Columbus Council 1690 of Whitewater and St. Mary's Catholic Church, where he was active in its Men's Club.

Steinhoff served on the Palmyra Village Board for 27 years and the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors from 1961 to 1966. He served as Palmyra village president from 1967 to 1971 and was re-elected in 1977. He was an active member of the Democratic Party.

Survivors include his wife; one son, Steven (Corinne) of Mukwonago; two daughters, Mrs. Glen (Bonnie) Schaefer of Monterey, Calif., and Mrs. Ronald (Susan) Mehring of Fort Atkinson; his stepmother, Therese of Eagle; two grandchildren; two sisters, Mrs. James (Carol) Foelker of Fort Atkinson and Mrs. Perry (Catherine) Eaton of West Bend; nieces; nephews; other relatives and friends.

He was preceded in death by a sister, Mary Steinhoff, and a stepsister, RuthAnn Steinhoff.
