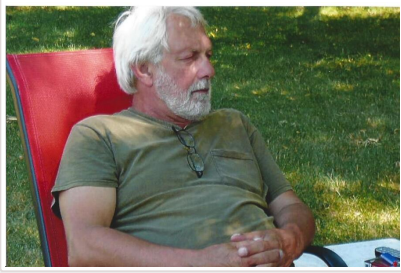


Jeffrey A. Villwock
